



**WELCOME to a fun-filled term of singing with the Women's Choral Society!
Here are answers to FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS about the choir.**

How do I join?

- Be one of the first 110 women to sign up and pay your \$70.00/term dues.
- No audition necessary.

How can I learn the music?

- **Rehearsals** happen every Monday evening, starting at 7:00 p.m. sharp, and ending by 9:00 p.m.
- You will be provided with a packet of **sheet music**, on loan to you. You can mark your music in pencil, but the music must be returned at the end of the term.
- **Recordings** of each part are available soon after the term starts. They can be downloaded or you can ask your section leader for a CD.
- Optional practice sessions for those singing on the same part (called **sectionals**) are held at members' homes throughout the term.

What happens at rehearsals?

- There is a warm-up period with coaching from the Conductor and an announcement period in the middle, followed by a brief break.
- We are serious about making beautiful music together, so to make the most of our singing time, we ask that everyone stay focused on the requests of the Conductor and the music.
- We are also committed to building a community, so enjoy the break time to talk with your fellow singers.
- **As a courtesy to all, please NO scented products.** (Cosmetics, lotions, perfumes, etc.)

What is GroupSpaces?

- A private way to e-mail members of the whole choir or subgroups and to share files. It is for members only, and we ask that you use the e-mail feature only for WCS choir business.
- If you are new, you will receive an e-mail inviting you to join. It's easy to follow the links and create your own password.

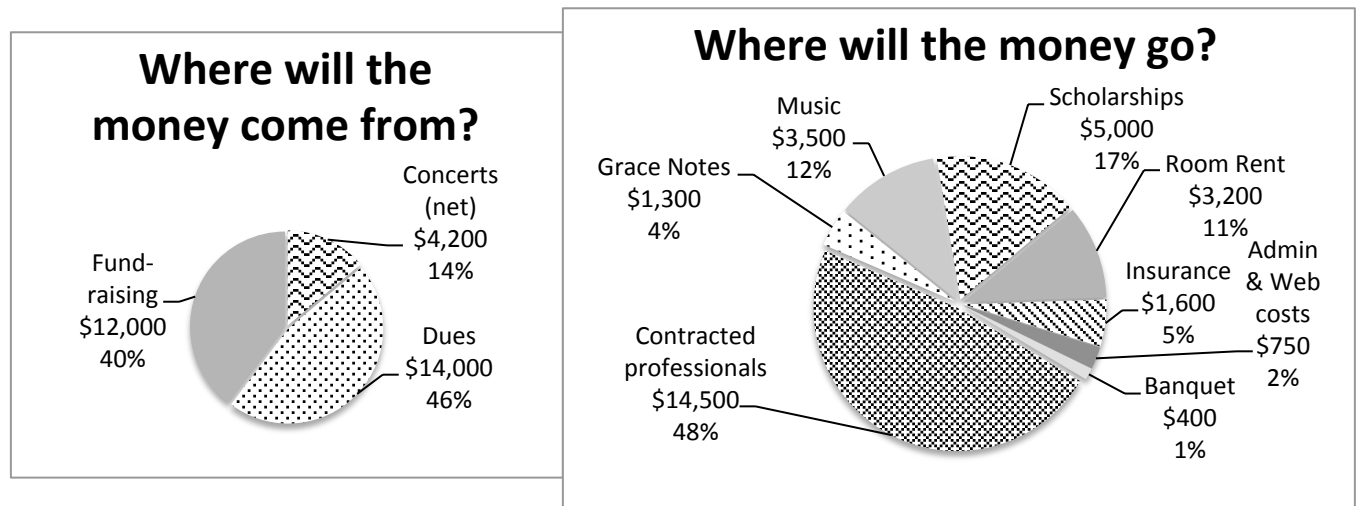

What can I do to help with choir operations?

- Join a committee.

What is the WCS budget?

- Funds come from dues (46%), concerts (14%) and donations (40%).
- Half the funds go to pay our professional conductor and accompanist.



What is Grace Notes and how can I join?

- Grace Notes is a sub-group of the choir. They represent WCS, performing in retirement and long-term care facilities and for community groups and events.
- New members are added in September.
